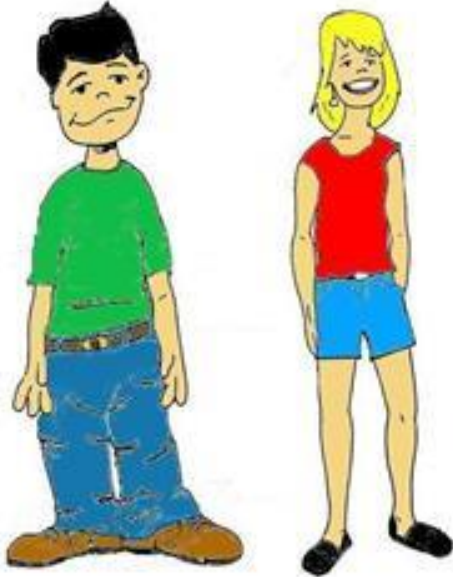

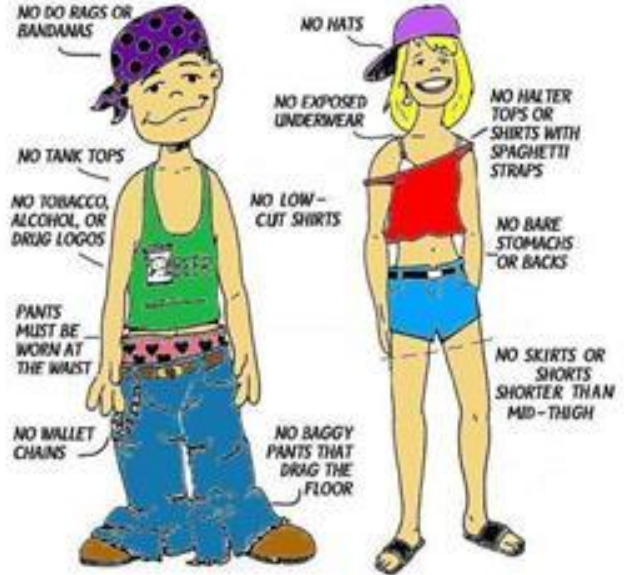
Dress Code Examples

Dress Code Do NOTs:

All examples apply to both male and female students



General Clothing Guidelines:

- Articles of clothing which display gang symbols, profanity or products or slogans that promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs or sex are prohibited.
- Shorts are to be worn no shorter than seven inches (7") above the top of the kneecap, but no shorter than mid-thigh.

MALE GUIDELINES:

- Tank tops and shirts with the arms cut off are not appropriate or acceptable.

FEMALE GUIDELINES:

- Shoulders straps on tops and dresses worn by females must **not be less than two inches in width**.
- Any apparel determined to be too revealing or draw undue attention to itself in style, fabric, or length is not acceptable. See-through clothing is not acceptable.
- Dresses with straps less than two inches in width will not be allowed. Dresses should be no shorter than seven inches above the kneecap.
- Bra straps should not be visible at any time.
- Beach wear, halter-tops, bare midriffs or chests, see-through outfits, or off the shoulder (or one shoulder) blouses are not appropriate or acceptable.

DRESS CODE DISCIPLINE POLICY:

- Student who are considered out of dress code are referred to the principal. If a student is determined to be out of dress code by the principal, the student will remain in the office until dress code regulations are met. Repeat offenders will face disciplinary action.
